

## For Reporting Calendar Year 2012

Pursuant to the Senate Order on departmental and agency contracts the following table sets out contracts entered into by Cancer Australia which provide for a consideration to the value of \$100,000 or more and which (a) have not been fully performed as at 31 December 2012 or (b) which have been entered into during the period.

**Note 1:** Most of the contracts listed contain confidentiality provisions of a general nature that are designed to protect the confidential information of the parties that may be obtained or generated in carrying out the contract. Reasons for including such clauses include: (a) ordinary commercial prudence that requires protection of trade secrets, proprietary information and the like; and / or (b) protection of other Commonwealth material and personal information.

**Note 2:** Columns (f) and (g) relate to specific contract schedules or clauses that have been inserted into the standard form contract that require the parties to maintain confidentiality of any of its provisions.
